Holy Week Schedule

March 27 – April 4

**Palm Sunday, March 27
10:00 a.m.**

We will bless the palms outside as we march in joyous procession to the church. This service begins in triumph as Jesus enters Jerusalem to shouts of



hosanna, but those shouts deteriorate into "Crucify him! as we read the Pas-

sion according to Luke. There will be no sermon as the Passion reading is powerful and provocative in itself.

We leave the church unsettled. This service concludes with no dismissal, and we will have no Coffee Hour on that day.

The portable Labyrinth will be set up in the Parish Hall Sunday through Wednesday noon. You are invited to walk the Labyrinth in silence following the Palm Sunday liturgy. Please use the front doors to enter and exit on that Sunday.

**Maundy Thursday, April 1
7:00 p.m.**

On this day four events are commemorated: Jesus washing

the disciples' feet, and offering them a "new" commandment – to love one another, the institution of the Lord's Supper, the watch in the Garden of Gethsemane, and the betrayal and trial of Jesus.

Join us in worship as we wash each other's feet, as Christ commanded, as a symbol of our servanthood and love for each other. At the end of the service the sanctuary will be stripped of all adornment. Following the eucharist we will hear the account of Jesus being arrested as we take the reserved Sacrament to the Altar of Repose in our new chapel.

**Watch at the Altar of Repose -
Maundy Thursday**

8:30 p.m. to 10 a.m Good Friday

Those who wish may say "yes" to Jesus question, "Can you not watch one hour with me?" by spending an hour in the church that night in our side chapel. A sign up sheet will be available on The Fifth Sunday of Lent.

**Good Friday, April 2
12 noon and 7:00 p.m.**

There will be no Eucharist celebrated on the day we mark Christ's death. Our liturgy bids us pray for the world and

ourselves, we read the Passion according to John, and are given an opportunity to approach and pray at the foot of the cross, symbolizing Christ's sacrifice.

**Holy Saturday, April 3 - The
Great Vigil of Easter
7:30 p.m.**

We light the "new fire of Easter" and dedicate the 2010 Paschal Candle, lighting our own candles from its flame. We begin the service outside, singing our way into the church, echoing ancient voices. We will gather around the font to hear the great stories of our faith as the skies darken: The Creation, the Flood, the deliverance at the Red Sea. We'll unpack the Alleluia banner as the lights go up in the church and we enter making a joyful noise, breaking out the bells. We celebrate the account of the Resurrection and the First Eucharist of Easter. (Bring bells from home to ring!)

**Easter Sunday, April 4
10:00 a.m.**

Festival Eucharist followed by our traditional Easter Egg hunt. (Bring bells from home to ring!)
